The health and safety of our patrons, staff, artists, and students is our top priority. In an effort to contain the spread of COVID-19, and in compliance with Sarasota County School's policy, all events at the Venice Performing Arts Center will be suspended, rescheduled, or postponed starting on Tuesday, March 17th 2020 until further notice. **Please note that all performances of Shen Yun scheduled in the VPAC Saturday March 14th through Monday March 16th will continue as planned.** If you feel that you should not attend a performance of Shen Yun due to health concerns, please contact the **Shen Yun box office at 888.974.3698.**

Next Saturday's performance of Dancing Dream- A Tribute to ABBA has been rescheduled to Saturday, November 14th, 2020. If you have tickets to ABBA, please do not call our box office. Look for an email with further details in the coming days.

The Venice Concert Band performance scheduled for Monday, March 24th has been postponed. Once additional information on rescheduling is clear, a member of VIPA or concert band staff will be in touch.

The Venice Symphony's concerts with Linda Eder scheduled for March 27th and 28th have been rescheduled to Saturday May 1st, and Sunday May 2nd, 2021. If you have tickets to this event, a member of The Venice Symphony staff will call you early next week.

Please be patient with us as we work to determine the best course of action for all events scheduled after March 28th, 2020. If you have purchased tickets to a future event, staff will reach out to you once they have answers to share.
